# Beautiful Irish Rose Necklace



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Size: 16" Diameter

Be the talk of the town with your Beautiful Irish Rose Necklace, or make them and give them away. You can also use them to top a gift in place of a bow.

## Material

#3 Thread - 0.58 oz Natural

Hook - "F"

Button - 1 button 1/2" diameter

Yarn Needle

## Gage

57 Fdc = 16"

## Instructions

### Fdc (foundation double crochet)

Start with a slip knot, ch 2, yarn over, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through one loop (the "chain"), yarn over and draw through 2 loops, yarn over and draw through last 2 loops (the "dc"). The following st is worked under the forward 2 loops of the stem of the previous st (into the "chain"). \* Yarn over, insert hook into the face of the "chain" and under the nub at the back of the "chain", yarn over and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through one loop (the "chain"), yarn over and draw through 2 loops, yarn over and draw through last 2 loops (the

"dc"). Repeat from \* for 16 inches (57 Fdc) or desired length. Do NOT fasten off.

## Button Hole

Chain 4 (or number for selected button), sl st in last foundation "chain". Tie off, weave in end.

## Button

Secure button on right side at beginning of Fdc.

## Attach Flower

See below for flower instructions. Secure flower on Fdc between button and button hole (at 29th Fdc).

## Flower

Finished size: 3 1/2" diameter

**Row 1** (Wrong side): Ch 57. (Dc, ch 2, dc) in sixth ch from hook (5 skipped chs count as first dc plus ch-2), \*ch 2, skip next 2 chs, (dc, ch 2, dc) in next ch; repeat from \* across: 36 sps.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, turn; 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, sc in first ch-2 sp, (6 dc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next ch-2 sp) 5 times, (9 dc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next ch-2 sp) 5 times, (12 dc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next sp) 7 times.

Thread yarn needle. Insert needle in base of first petal made; roll petals to form rose and loosely sew petals to base of first petal as you roll. Tie off weave in ends.
